Maine Composites Alliance Membership Dues

Membership runs on a yearly basis from January 1 to December 31.

Any person, firm, corporation or organization engaged in the manufacture or distribution of equipment, materials and supplies, or delivering services, consultation or education in the state of Maine is eligible for Regular Membership.
